## Information on using your library card

We are happy to welcome you to the Solomon Wright Public Library in Pownal, Vermont! Now that you have a library card, you can borrow books, museum passes, and items from our Library of Things. You can also use our digital resources: Overdrive/Libby, The Palace Project, and the Vermont Library. The Vermont Library website includes Udemy and Peterson's test prep. ### Check out periods for materials are:

- **Books - 3 weeks** (can be renewed)
- **Library of Things**, including Peckham Toy Library - **1 week** (can be renewed once)
- **Museum/ski/state park passes - 3 days** (no renewals)

Passes can be requested for a specific date by phone or email. We will do our best to accommodate those requests. **\*\*Passes will only be held until the end of the day if a patron calls to place a hold on a pass.**

**Books or passes can be returned at our front desk or in the blue book drop at our front door. Library of Things need to be returned at the front desk.**

**To access Overdrive/Libby for ebooks and audiobooks:** Find our library name and use your library card bar code. The password is your last name, all in capital letters. Please allow a week after you receive a card to make sure you're in the system.

**To access The Palace Project for ebooks and audiobooks:** Let us know that you would like this information. It's a little tricky, but we can help!

You can request books through **interlibrary loan** at our circulation desk. A volunteer will help you fill out the form. Books come in via courier on Fridays. We will contact you when they are ready to pick up. Loan periods are one month from when the library receives the book or material.

**Hours:** Monday, Wednesday, Friday: 10 am - 6 pm, Saturday: 10 am - 12 pm
